<u>Instructions on using the Google Meet for online sessions.</u>

Alhamdulillah, we will be using Google Meet to conduct the online face-to-face classes. Please follow the instruction below. You will receive a timetable for Google Meets in a separate document which will show your class times and days.

- You must join your classroom when it is time for your lesson, you will not be able to join earlier.
- Your lesson will start according to the timetable promptly.
- Throughout the duration of your class, you must keep your **microphone audio on mute** unless instructed by your teacher to do otherwise.
- If you have an urgent question or comment, please use the chat function.
- You must not use the chat function as an area for small talk
- You must be **sitting in a quiet room** so that you can give your full attention
- You must have your book/ notepad ready to take notes you can also use word (or other applications of your preference)
- You cannot video/ audio record the lesson(s) without getting permission from your teacher
- You need to double check your Google Classroom as your subject teacher may upload notes, exercises or other work that needs to be completed

Note:

Your Google Classroom will only display the 'meet icon' at the scheduled time of your lesson.

Your lessons will be from 12-12.35.

A register will be taken at the beginning and end of your lesson so don't be late!


Your Google Classroom lessons will still be ongoing.

Your Google Meets timetable with start on the Monday 1st June.




Joining by Google Classroom

- Step 1 Check your timetable and enter that 'classroom' at the allocated time
- Step 2 In the stream section of your classroom, you will find at meet link appear. Click on that to be redirected to you Google Classroom online session



or select classwork and an icon will appear next to 'Google Calendar'.



Step 3 – Select Join now and you will enter the online video classroom
